September 2018

Over the last few weeks we have been settling a lot of children into Nursery the children have been getting used to our class routines and developing new friendships whilst the class teachers and TAs will begin to 'baseline' the children. Baseline is an initial assessment of the children which allows us to make informed decisions, helping us to understand what your child's next step in learning is and how to best facilitate this.

Our topics for the next two half terms is as follows;

Autumn 1 – Who lives in my house?

We will be looking at family pictures and talking about who is in our family. We will be looking at where we live? What house we live in? What is our house made of?

We will be using ICT (Google Street view to find our houses and with your help pictures of your houses.)

Reading stories like "The Three Little Pigs", My New Friend, We are Family and many more stories.

Autumn 2 - Where does the day go at night?

This is a fun topic as we will be discussing what we do in the day and night and what we might see in the changing seasons.

What animals we see in the different parts of the day.

Throughout the term we will also be learning about season changing and festivals we may celebrate.

As learning in Nursery is child led, we don't like to plan too far in advance so often there will be mini topics in between that have been influenced by the interests of the children.
