

Dear Parents

As part of our History topic on The Great Fire of London this term, we are taking the children in year 2 (class 5 and 6) to Staircase House in Stockport. This is will be an exciting opportunity for children to dress up and re-enact the events of The Great Fire in the specially designed 17th century rooms. There will be an opportunity for children to take part in making a 'wattle and daub' panel that provides insight into house construction in the seventeenth century. We believe that this will be an amazing opportunity to bring History to life for the children.

The trip will take place on Monday 21st January and will be at a cost of £10.50 per child. This includes the coach fare to and from Stockport. Payment can be made in the usual method via parent pay.

The payment of the trip also acts as your permission for your child to attend the trip. Children should arrive at school at the normal time and be appropriately dressed in their own school uniform.
