Phonics

- We teach 'Read, Write, Inc' (RWI) everyday.
- Children will have access to other phonics activities throughout the school day.
- Phonics Screening Check (May)
- How you can help at home practise segmenting and blending words, read everyday at home and practise writing high frequency words.

Safeguarding

• If parents are to ever come into school they are to enter via the office and sign in.

• End of the day – 2 classes are coming out so please be patient as we want to make sure all children leave safely.

Reading books and Spellings

- As said previously, all children have a RWI lesson everyday, however, it is vital
 that you read with them everyday too.
- Children will still have the same login for Bug club to access further books (see handout) which your child's teacher will have uploaded for them.
- The snuggle up book is to be read with the children by an adult.
- The phonetically decodable book is to be read to an adult by the child. Please listen to your child read and ask questions throughout to reinforce their understanding.
- Spellings this half term will be focusing on our common exception words (see handout) we will break these spellings up each week to send home.
- Children will practise spelling in school, but again, you need to be practising them at home as well.

Homework

- Each child will be given a homework bag.
- Homework will be given out every Friday and it must be returned on the following <u>Wednesday</u>. This will include a snuggle up book, a phonetically decodable book (at your child's level), a piece of maths.
- New spellings will be sent home every Tuesday after the spelling test.
- Books <u>will not</u> be changed every day. Children should read a book more than once and should discuss and answer questions on what they have read.
- Our spelling test will be done on a <u>Tuesday</u> so make sure they have practiced up until that day.

Last few bits...

- Children in KS1 are entitled to free school meals please don't swap between a pack lunch and dinner, as it becomes confusing as to who has pack lunch or not.
- Children get a snack at break time.
- Please provide water bottles, named and with only water in it.
- Please also name all clothing, especially jumpers, cardigans and PE kit, as this
 will help the items find their way back to your child, should they get lost.
- Year 1 PE Day will be on a Wednesday. They must come in to school in their kit.
- Your children shouldn't be bringing in any personal belongings/toys to school.
- Please speak to a member of staff if you have any worries or questions we are anyways available on the doors.
