Dear Parents and Neighbours,

Trafford Council has a duty to provide school places for every child resident within the borough. This duty has been met by expanding a number of Primary Schools across the borough to meet local demand. Gorse Hill Primary School has been experiencing increased demand for places in recent year leading to 60 pupils (2 classes per year group) rather than the usual 50 being accepted each year. Therefore the Council proposes to add further accommodation in order to allow the school to properly function as a 2 form entry.

The Council together with the Governing Body would like to invite you to a consultation afternoon/evening on Thursday 18th January 2018 from 3:00 to 6.00pm, at the school. You will have the chance to look at sketch plans of the proposals and comment on the potential development.
