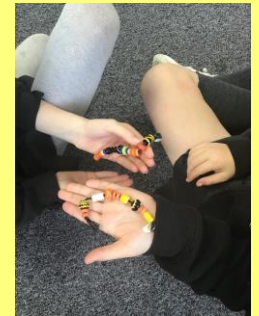


Happy Half Term!
