Builders are aiming to complete the new extension by 8th February 2019 however internal decoration and furnishing will then need to start. I can now inform parents that school will be closed to pupils from the **27th-29th March** inclusive in order for staff to move into the new building. Once we have moved into the new extension, further work will commence to the existing classrooms to create a food technology room, library, community room and staffroom. The fencing to the MUGA pitch is nearly complete however, the current surface is only temporary as the actual surface cannot be laid unless temperatures are above 10 degrees. I hope that the new additional pupil entrance on Cavendish Road at the side of the MUGA pitch will be completed early in the new year.
